



Positive Behavioral Supports Training:

In an effort to meet the training requirements, the Employer of Record (EOR) has the option of having staff attend NCI Part A or Alternatives to Restrictive Intervention, following an approved curriculum.

The EOR can use the material to train direct care staff and ensure documentation of training provided is maintained in the employees file. The training is not competency-based.

NCI Part or Alternatives to Restrictive Intervention training should occur prior to the employee working with an individual and annually thereafter. Please note that [this training](#) is not mandatory, but it is expected that there is training documentation to support your staff either attending NCI Part A or other form of Alternatives to Restrictive Interventions training.
