

# INNOVATIONS SERVICES waitlist

The NC Innovations Waiver is a health plan for people with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities in North Carolina. It allows people to receive services and supports in their homes and communities instead of an institution.

The North Carolina General Assembly decides how many people receive these services, commonly called Waiver slots. Like other managed care organizations, Cardinal Innovations keeps a list of people interested in receiving these services. This list is called the Registry of Unmet Needs or the IDD Waitlist. Waiver slots are assigned based on two factors: 1) the date someone is placed on the Registry and 2) the number of people already receiving NC Innovations Services in their county.

**The data here is for Fiscal Year 2020 (July 2019 to June 2020), but these numbers are constantly changing. Also important to note, some people on the IDD Waitlist receive both state-funded and (b)(3) services at the same time.**
